Thank you for your consultation on the discharge of condition 19 which relates to the delivery of biodiversity net gain.

I can confirm that I am satisfied with the report prepared by Archer Ecology (Sept 2023) and it is clear from the BNG assessment that the site landscape scheme is capable of achieving in excess of the required 10%. The report relies on those retained, enhanced and created habitats being managed to target condition for a period of 30 years.

As such, I would have expected to see a series of monitoring intervals included within the proposals. Can I suggested BNG condition assessments at Years 3, 5, 10, 20 and 30 as a minimum to ensure progress towards the targets. If the intended condition is not being met at these intervals then there may be a need to change the management prescription or include further interventions. In these circumstances additional monitoring at mid points (Years 15 and 25) may also be needed.
