There are so many reasons why I think this application should not be accepted , however my main concerns are the environmental impact on health, the countryside and tourism.

- Increased HGVS on our roads and the affect on pedestrians especially children who they will be passing on their way to and from school.

- The chemicals on these HGVS, and the affect on the environment and people through extraction and transportation. Spillages/ accidents happen. We only have to look at the recent news in the North Sea.

- Noise pollution from the drilling rig and HGVs

- Heritage Coast / Cinder Track / Cleveland Way. I don't think it's acceptable to carry out Hydraulic Fracturing anywhere never mind near areas such as this. Tourism will be impacted for which Scarborough is reliant.

- The potential for the water course to be affected. Once it's damaged it could mean the disappearance of our villages - Council Tax payers

- The potential for subsidence to properties. Houses won't sell, villages disappear. No Council Tax

- The access to the site goes through the parking and access for the RNLI vehicles. I don't think this is acceptable as rescue times could be affected.

Having attended the presentations from Europa, they didn't fill me with confidence as they contradicted their own figures displayed on the noticeboards. It won't provide jobs for locals as they have their own work force and the gas produced won't go to the local or UK economy as it will be sold on the Open Market.

On the government and country's mission to go to Net Zero, and our understanding of using fossil fuels I feel strongly that Hydraulic Fracturing should not be carried out anywhere on this planet.
