Dear Ms Taylor,

I am writing to you in reference to the planning application at Land East of the Mill Yard, Burniston Mill (Ref. NY/2025/0030/ENV). I strongly object to the proposal, on various grounds.

There is scientific consensus on the devastating impact of continued use of fossil fuels. This development would deeply harm all communities worldwide when the gas that has been extracted is then later used, creating more carbon dioxide and methane. Other UK sites have been closed due to the harmful impact of extracting gas through fracking. It is clear that the UK should be investing heavily in renewable energy sources and not in these archaic methods.

As someone who was born and bred in Yorkshire, I cannot support the irreparable damage this development will do to the local communities from the risk of underground tremors, and from the lost natural coastline environment which so many rely on for their leisure and livelihoods.

I have close family living in the area and would be deeply concerned for their health from risk of pollution to both air and local water sources should this proceed.
