I wish to strongly object to the plans submitted by Europa Oil and Gas to drill for gas within metres of houses in Burniston with devastating effects on the villages of Burniston, Cloughton and Scalby. The proximity of weak cliffs and the risk of earth tremors caused by drilling over coastal geological faults is very, very worrying. The noise and light pollution and the emission of toxic fumes and horrid smells and the prospect of 1000 HGVs on the already congested roads in the area will have a detrimental affect on the health of residents and potentially a negative affect on visitor numbers.

At a time when the UK is moving to renewable, clean energy, these plans to drill for gas in an area of scenic beauty are totally inappropriate.

This would devastate the surrounding countryside, the Heritage Coastline and the Cleveland Way and most certainly lead to a decline in visitor numbers which in turn would negatively affect local businesses.
