Comments:

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to express my opposition to the proposed fracking site at Burniston.

I moved to the village over 3 years ago because of its rural location and believe that the proposed site will be detrimental to this, both in terms of human and wildlife populations. The site is just metres away from local houses and close to areas of natural beauty including the Cinder track which I walk every day with my baby.

I am already aware of a friend who was looking to move to Burniston who has now delayed her decision to move to the village to wait and see if the fracking will come to pass. This is just one example of how I believe the local housing market will be affected. I am also concerned about how it may affect the saleability of my own property in future.

In addition, the negative impact of noise pollution and additional traffic in the village is something I am concerned about. We are already seeing many more heavy goods vehicles following the various house building projects in the area.

The local economy will not benefit as the gas is sold internationally. I do not feel that the village should have to suffer the disruption.
