I am objecting to the proposed fracking at Burniston near Scarborough.

It seems obvious that this is a very bad idea for many reasons. Burniston is a lovely village set in a beautiful area close to the North Yorkshire National park, Cleveland Way and Heritage Coast. So in an area visited by thousands of tourists every year. Imagine an industrial site right on your doorstep and then say it won't have an impact.

The drilling for gas will last 37 weeks initially. Imagine the noise,dust and light pollution 24/7. Gas flaring day and night producing toxic fumes and sick making smells. Then twenty years of production with four more rigs added.

The drilling above Peak Fault (a major fault) could set off earthquakes as it did in Lancashire a few years ago causing damage to properties and the whole thing abandoned. The cliffs nearby could become unstable putting the Cleveland Way at risk.

Imagine if you're a local and have lived in this peaceful place for years never thinking you will have an industrial site on your doorstep and the effect it would have on your mental health . The area is quiet, a farming area visited by people who love the scenery, the coast, the seabirds nesting there. Tourism businesses will inevitably suffer losses.

I thought we had won the battle against fracking and let's be honest this is what it is . People don't want fracking in this country when their water supplies could be contaminated. Methane is a worse gas than CO2 for warming the climate. The government has banned fracking and they should ban all new drilling for gas on land in order to meet our climate commitments. We won't get cheaper gas.
