Comments:

Dear Sir/Madam, i strongly object to this application for the following reasons.

Fracking, which this process is in all but name, has been proven to cause pollution to local water sources. The countryside around the area is used for farming with livestock and could contaminate the land they graze and drink from. Any pollution would also affect wildlife, particularly aquatic creatures.

Previously Fracking, near Blackpool, has caused Earthquakes which has been measured above the permitted levels, this can cause structural damage to nearby buildings.

The operations site would be located in a the North York Moors national park and close to The Cleaveland way. It is a totally unsuitable operation to have in this area due to the visual impact, risk of pollution and increase in heavy goods vehicles.

We are in a Climate emergency, our own Committee on Climate Change has said there should be no new oil and gas drilling if we are to have a livable future. This operation therefore must not be permitted to go ahead as the emissions from it will just add to the problems we face. It is time to look to the future and move away from Fossil Fuels.
