New comments have been received for application NY/2025/0030/ENV from Mrs Patricia Critchlow .

Comments:

I object to planning application NY/2005/0030/ENV Due to the following concerns.

Environmental grounds due to drilling 24/7, dust pollution, gas flaring and possible water supply issues.

Industrial Pollution

The proximity of the drill site very close to our homes and villages with the possible 20 years of production of gas and a further 4 rigs.

The proximity of the drill 1 km from our coastal paths with its weak cliffs and the National Park.

Disruption to traffic on our already busy narrow roads. We have lorries serving the construction of new houses on High Mills that use Scalby Rd, Burniston Rd , Station Rd and Field Lane . The damage to road surfaces is considerable and the safety of pedestrians already an issue. The potentially hundreds of journeys by HGVs due to this development is unsustainable given our road systems.

Living as close as we do to this proposed drilling site and to the cliffs only a 10 minute walk away we have real concerns over earth tremors caused by drilling over coast geological faults.

Finally Climate Change and it's implications for our planet's future is at the heart of my objections.

Anything that involves the burning of gases that increase more CO2 and methane into the air is an absolute NO especially as other such sites in the UK were shut down due to downstream gas emissions. As a country we are supposed be moving to clean energy not proven polluting energy. NO to this dreadful proposal.
