I wish to express my objection to the submission by Europa and its intent to exploit gas reserves through propponant squeeze methods at Burniston in North Yorkshire.

This would have a severe impact on village life with significant noise and traffic disruption. There will inevitably be heavy duty vehicles such as lorries and tankers trundling through the village with detrimental effect on the quality of life of the villagers.
