New comments have been received for application NY/2025/0030/ENV from mrs Joanna Bax.

Comments:

I write to object to the planing application above on the following grounds

1 This is a form of fracking albeit by another name and we do not need more fossil fuels as we are supposed to be going to wards a greener country.

2 there is a major fault line in the cliffs near to the fracking zone. The cliffs already are regularly collapsing with heavy rain etc so this process could easily speed up the process

3 The site is near the national park and the Cleveland way both of which provide tourism into the area which is a boost to the local economy. The drilling will not add to the economy but would detract from it due to industrial activity, increased traffic on already too busy badly maintained roads, cause pollution from flaring and spoil both the dark skies and the nature in this area

4 This is taking up valuable farmland which should be used for crowing crops to provide for our local economy

5 the company will not be producing cheap gas for the neighbourhood most of which don't even have gas . It is an American company and the profits made will go to the shareholders

6 traffic increase due too the over sized lorries and rigs coming in would be unmanageable. The roads are already over congested especially in the tourist season and if traffic is using the road too York this would further cause problems with ambulances taking emergency cases to York hospital which is already causing issues in this area

7 there are significant numbers of both elderly and very young in the area and the site would have a huge impact on the health and welling of everyone
