Comments:

The proposed site is close to our home and we are concerned about the impact it will have on our own quality of life and that of our children. We understand that there will be noise 24/7 and gas flares.

We are specifically worried about toxic chemicals which may contaminate the air and water locally. We have children with allergies and asthma and so this is a huge concern to us.

We need to protect this beautiful and unique area and the varied wildlife that live here.
