Comments:

I object on the grounds of climate change.

The IPCC has clearly stated that greenhouse gas emissions from existing fossil fuel infrastructure is more than enough to push the world beyond 1.5C of global heating compared with pre-industrial times. We cannot afford more fossil fuel development.

Europa is selective and thereby disingenuous in its evidence in this regard, comparing the carbon footprint of UK produced gas with imported LNG. Gas imported from Norway has a lower footprint according to UK government data, yet this is not mentioned for balance.

A far greater contribution can be made to genuine energy security by reducing demand through domestic insulation programs, as proven in the first decade of this century when UK gas demand was slashed by 20% through such measures.

At this critical time, fossil fuel expansion cannot be deemed to be sustainable development.
