I am extremely concerned at the proposed developments on our beautiful north Yorkshire coast. I grew up in Scarborough and visit my family here every six weeks.

The developments will be dangerous to air, soil and water quality in the short, medium and long term, as well as contributing to the climate crisis. The fundamental issue is that no further investment should be made to fossil fuels. We should be looking for alternatives. We should respect the land, and local people, by taking care of water, soil and air, not allowing exploitation of the land for others' power and profit. Oil and gas exploration is also visually ugly - in a region where tourism is such an important part of our identity as well as our economy, allowing this development seems like madness.
